- The main purpose of LinkedIn API is User's Convenience, User does not have to provide or fill other details apart from their LinkedIn Username and Password.
- LinkedIn API provides Authentication and Security for User's personal details so it is totally secured.
- Using LinkedIn API Admin can obtain User's First Name, Last Name.

Steps to Create LinkedIn API

Step -1

- User has to navigate <https://www.linkedin.com/>

Step -2

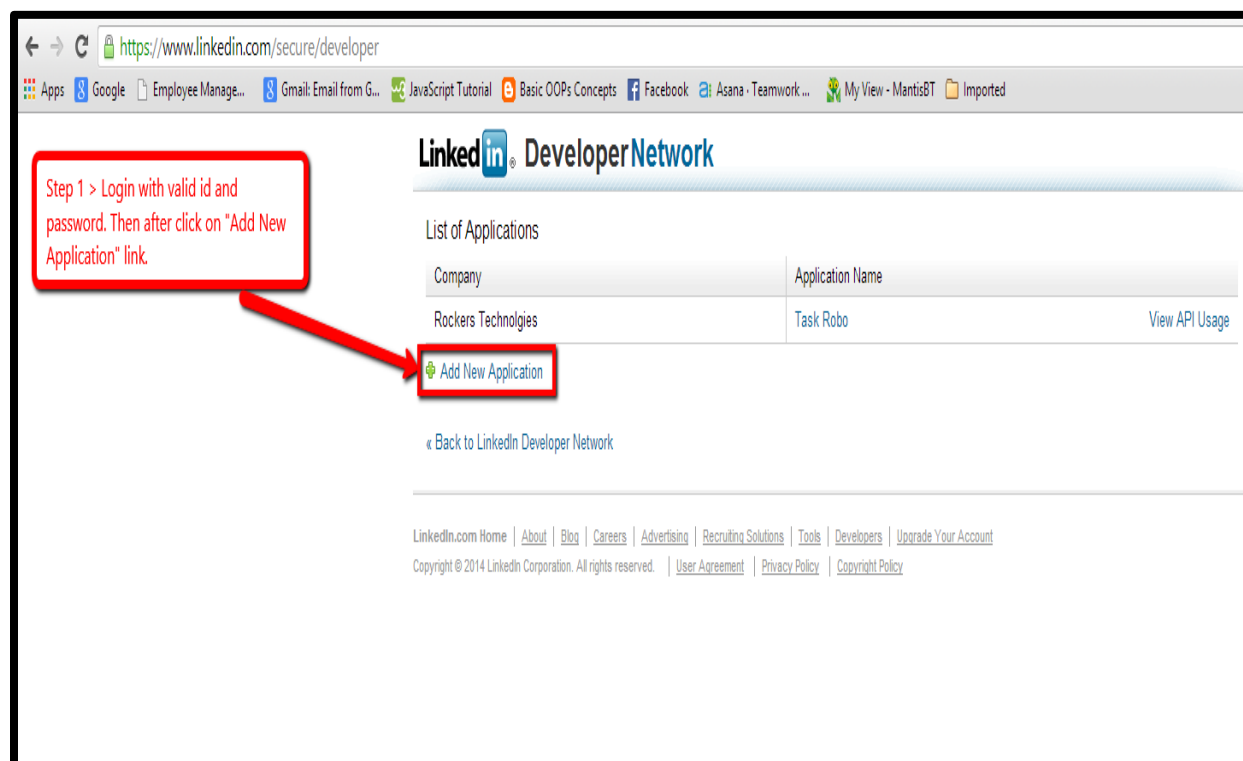
- User has to Login in with his/her Valid User Name & Password.

OAuth 2.0 Redirect URL:

Comma separated list of absolute URLs allowed for OAuth 2.0 redirections. We strongly encourage using HTTPS.

OAuth 1.0 Accept Redirect URL:
URL to return users to your app after they grant access. Only used if you do not pass in the oauth_callback parameter in the requestToken call.

OAuth 1.0 Cancel Redirect URL:

URL to return users to your app if they select Cancel from the OAuth dialog. If specified, this field will be used for the Cancel button redirect, otherwise the oauth_callback will be used and will include the parameter oauth_problem with the value user_refused.

App Logo Secure URL:
URL of an 80x80 logo for your app. SSL is required.

* Agreement Language:
Select the display language of the user agreement screen. Browser Locale Setting is recommended.

Other

JavaScript API Domains:

Comma separated list of fully-qualified domain names of all pages that will call the JavaScript API. Only needed if using Javascript API. Must include protocol, host, and port (if not 80 or 443).
